



2019-20 K-8 Uniform Policy

Parkridge Christian Academy is a uniformed school to ensure safety, modesty and neatness in addition to allowing all students the freedom to be themselves apart from the stress of competition in attire. PCA reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/ or make changes during the school year.

Uniforms – Students in all grades must wear the full school uniform during the school day except on announced, special occasions. All uniform tops, bottoms and outerwear must be supplied by Flynn O’Hara at www.flynnohara.com. Students may not alter the uniform in anyway.

K-8th (All) PE uniform (t-shirt / gym shorts) / Field Trip t-shirt / Fleece (optional) / ¼ zip jacket (optional)

*Girls K-2nd Polo (navy, red, or white) / PeterPan collar blouse (short /long sleeve) / Pants/Shorts (khaki / navy)
Dress (navy/red) Jumper (navy/plaid) / skort (khaki, navy, or plaid)
Dress Uniform: White PeterPan collar blouse with Plaid jumper*

*Girls 3rd -8th Polo (navy, red, or white) / Pants/Shorts (khaki/navy) / Skort (khaki, navy, or plaid)
Dress Uniform: Navy polo with Plaid skort*

*Boys K-8th Polo (navy, red, rugby, or white) / Pants/Shorts (khaki / navy)
Dress Uniform: Navy polo, Khaki pants*

Shirts – All shirts must be supplied from, which includes PCA’s logo, Flynn O’ Hara. Undershirts may not be exposed beneath the uniform shirt. On days which the temperature is below 70 degrees students are permitted to wear long sleeve undershirts in colors red, navy blue or white with no letters, designs or picture(s).

Bottoms (Slacks, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers) – All bottoms must be worn at the natural waist and purchased from Flynn O’ Hara. For girls, the length of bottoms should be no more than two inches (2”) above the knee and not shortened by rolling up the waistband or cuff. Girls wearing dresses and jumpers should wear navy/black bike shorts underneath. On days which the temperature is below 70 degrees girls are permitted to wear navy leggings underneath their jumper, skort, or PE shorts.

Outer Wear – Students may wear a navy fleece /jacket with the PCA logo, supplied by Flynn O’ Hara.

Footwear – Students must wear closed, toe and back, shoes at all times (e.g. athletic shoes or dress shoes). No wheeled sneakers, slippers, pointed/above ankle height boots, sandals, flip-flops or croc-style shoes.

Hair – Students are to keep their hair neat and well groomed. There should be no coloring / dyeing of hair using unnatural colors or shaved designs. Hair that is distracting in an educational setting will not be allowed. The administration reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of hairstyles for boys and/or girls.

Other Items – Wallet chains, hats, sunglasses, bandanas, scarves, etc. are not permitted on campus during the school day. Visible tattoos or body piercings are not permitted. Boys may not wear earrings on campus, or at any school function.

Uniform consequences – Students out of uniform will be sent to the office and stay there until a parent brings the proper uniform for the student. Consequences will follow the Discipline Matrix included in the Parent / Student Handbook.

Students will be given a grace period from August 14-23. An email will be sent to parents of students who are not in full uniform during these days. Beginning Monday, August 26, the regular consequences will be enforced.
